

Who's FFKC for?

Camp is free of charge to any kid that:

- Has been treated in a burn unit (or who has been hospitalized for burn-related injuries) and
- Is between the ages of six (and has completed the first grade) and 17 years of age

Firefighters Kids Camp serves children in California and Nevada (and sometimes beyond!). Transportation to and from camp is provided from pre-designated points within Northern California but may be arranged for eligible kids coming from other areas. We often work with Angel Flight West for campers in Southern California.

Age-appropriate siblings are also invited to apply to camp—they are an important part of the healing journey! Sibling applications are evaluated on an individual basis and are subject to space availability.



Volunteering & Staff

Our program is staffed by a well-trained and enthusiastic group of volunteers which are firefighters, burn care professionals, and adult burn survivors. Maturity and good judgement are two desirable qualities looked for in candidates. Staff must be at least 21 years of age. We also welcome Counselors-In-Training. CITs are typically burn survivors and campers 18-to-20 years old that are interested in transitioning into a new role as cabin counselor. No prior experience as a camper or CIT is required, but preferred.
